Developing Motor Skills

- ❖ Working on Gross Motor Skills helps a child gain strength and confidence in his/her body. Do activities like catching a ball, balancing, moving like an animal, cycling, jumping on a trampoline, hopping on one foot etc.
- ❖ Fine Motor Skills involve the use of the small muscles that control the hand, fingers and thumb. Activities like buttoning and zipping clothes, coloring, clay molding, building with Legos and blocks, beading etc. helps to build a child's self-esteem and confidence also.

Reading is Fun

Children are made readers on the laps of their parents.

- Make reading a regular practice with pictures and large text.
- Read out value based stories from panchatantra or any other story book.
- Make bed-time stories a part of your child's daily routine.

Be a Friend

- Identify a family game like cricket, football, volleyball, etc. and play with your child every weekend.
- Take your child for nature walk and explore different leaves, insects, pebbles, these while walking.



Alphabetical Order


Read this list of words. Look at their first letters.
